Projects at the Turtle

Keeping the property looking good and functioning properly is no small task. Some of the recent projects around the property include:


• The pool and hot tub were both resurfaced over the winter. Both were damaged from the hurricanes of 2022 and in need of repair and resurfacing. We were shocked to see the contractor took out about five inches of built-up plaster from prior resurfacing. This new surface looks great and should last us about 10 years.

• A new drain was installed a the East end of the parking lot. This is near the handicap ramp where the water would gather when we had hard rain. The new drain will prevent the standing water in that area.

• During the storms in the fall of 2024, the North dividing wall between The Turtle Inn and The Sea Club IV took on strong winds and was at risk of falling. The wall has been replaced and the corner where it ties into the sea wall has been reinforced.

In addition to these major projects, many smaller projects have been completed. You will notice new painting in many areas of the property, additional landscaping, as will as electrical upgrades and lighting.

Don't worry, we have plenty on our To-Do List. We work tirelessly to keep the Turtle looking and functioning at its peak.
